Therefore, the recommendation reflects the termination of Advance Security Systems and The PC Doctors of Florida as awardees on Contract No. 062-GG11 and the loss of eligibility to transact new business with the Board for a period of fourteen (14) months, pursuant to School Board Policy 6320 – Purchasing.
