The following "Superintendent Authorized Requisitions" (SAR) had a purchase order issued within the guidelines of Board Policy 6320, Purchasing, which states that emergency purchases made in accordance with Board Policy 6320, Purchasing, and approved by the Superintendent or his designee, will be reported to the Board as soon as possible.

This emergency request was required to continue critical nursing services for students with disabilities, for whom such services have been identified as necessary to access education (IEP or 504 Plan). The current emergency contract for these services expired on December 31, 2012, which necessitated this extended emergency action.

The term of the extended emergency action is effective through June 30, 2013, to provide continuity of services, while the Request For Proposals evaluation process and internal audit are being completed and a recommendation for award is presented to the Board.

Failure to provide these critical nursing services would severely impact the health and safety of the students.
