Tour operators offer chaperones to travel at no cost for a designated number of participants.

The students and teachers participating in the trip will be registered with the U.S. Department of State by utilizing their on-line Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) which is a free service provided by the United States Government. By registering trip participants with STEP, the Department of State can better assist them in an emergency.

The students will provide a written report to their principal summarizing the highlights, experiences and educational value of the trip. The reports will also be posted on the school's website for other students to review.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the out-of-country field trip to London, England; Paris, Colmar, Alsace, France; Frankfurt, Munich, Germany; Rome, Florence, Venice, Italy; and Lucerne, Switzerland for the students at Young Women's Preparatory Academy.
