Never having trained for running nor competed in any event in her life, Ms. Sampson dove in headfirst by walking, jogging and running five to eight miles every morning, five-days-a-week, and doing yoga and stretching in the evenings. In February 2002, she competed in her first race, the 2002 South Florida Senior Games, at the age of 62. She came in first place and received her first gold medal.

The win enabled Ms. Sampson to qualify for the 2002 Florida Senior Games State Championship. She made a personal record and brought home the silver. By August 2006, Ms. Sampson was being ranked number three in the nation in her age category.

Currently, Ms. Sampson competes in the South Florida Senior Games, the National Senior Games, the Masters Invitational Track Meet, Atlanta Senior Olympics, USA Track & Field National Masters Championships, the Southeastern USA Track & Field Master Championships, and the Southeastern Masters Regional Championships. In her spare time, she speaks and shares her story with students at various schools in Miami-Dade and Broward counties.
