The budget development schedule mandated by state law will not result in an adopted FY 2013-14 budget prior to the start of the FY 2013-14 fiscal year. Therefore, it is necessary for the Board to authorize the Superintendent to expend funds for the next fiscal year to meet payrolls and expenses until such time as the budget is adopted.

Florida Statute 1011.08 authorizes the Board to approve expenditures between July 1, 2013 and the date the tentative budget becomes official which is scheduled to occur on July 25, 2013.

It is recommended that the Board authorize the FY 2012-13 fiscal year budget, as amended, to be used as a continuation budget for FY 2013-14, effective July 1, 2013, until such time as the FY 2013-14 tentative budget becomes official.
