This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. One (1) vendor responded to this advertised solicitation.

The term of the bid shall be for two (2) years from the date of award and may, by mutual agreement between The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the awardee, be extended for three (3) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed. ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date of the current contract period.

Strategies were employed to increase MWBE & SBE/MBE participation and one (1) M/WBE vendor was awarded.

The original price submitted, was negotiated with the vendor which resulted in a cost savings of \$25,000.

Attempts were made to benchmark against The School Board of Broward County, Florida, however, the terms and conditions are not similar, so benchmarking could not be performed.
