SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 1, FY 2014-15 SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS – RACE TO THE TOP (RTTT) FUND MID-YEAR BUDGET REVIEW

COMMITTEE: FISCAL ACCOUNTABILITY

LINK TO STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK: FINANCIAL EFFICIENCY/STABILITY

The Special Revenue Funds include the Other Federal Programs (Contracted Programs) Fund, Food Services Fund, Race To The Top (RTTT) Fund, Targeted American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Stimulus Funds, Other Stimulus Grants and Miscellaneous Funds. The purpose of this resolution is to make budget amendments to the RTTT budget which are required to fully comply with grant terms and/or good accounting practices.

The FY 2014-15 Adopted Budget included only the final FY 2013-14 unexpended balances of grants which would continue operating in FY 2014-15 and new grant awards received prior to adoption date.

This resolution amends budgeted revenues and appropriations in the RTTT Fund by \$95,948. This increase represents the value of individual grant awards reviewed and approved by the School Board subsequent to the adoption of the FY 2014-15 budget on September 3, 2014 through December 31, 2014 and a minor adjustment to the amount previously carried forward from FY 2013-14. The shift of dollars from salaries/fringes to Contracted Programs is for the recruiting component of the grant to recruit promising teachers for Miami-Dade.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. adopt Resolution No. 1, FY 2014-15 Special Revenue Funds – Race To The Top Fund Mid-Year Budget Review, increasing revenues and appropriations by \$95,948 and
2. adopt the Summary of Revenues and Appropriations (page 2) and the Summary of Appropriations by Function (page 4).
