ACCORDANCE WITH OMB CIRCULAR A-133, JUNE 30, 2014**

The external independent audit firm, McGladrey LLP, has published the Federal Single Audit Reports of Miami-Dade County District School Board for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2014. The audit, which encompasses both financial and compliance components, was performed to determine the District's adherence to the requirements described in the United States Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-133 applicable to each of its major federal programs. This is the final report issued by McGladrey LLP for the same period. Previously, the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) and their Management Letter were presented to the School Board at its December 10, 2014, and January 15, 2015, meetings as agenda items E-86 and E-91, respectively.

The external auditors reported that the School Board of Miami-Dade County prepared its financial statements in accordance with prescribed financial reporting standards. Accordingly there was no indication of any deficiencies in the District's internal control over financial reporting; and their tests of compliance did not disclose any material noncompliance with significant provisions of laws, regulations, contracts and grant agreements which could directly impact on the determination of financial statements amounts.

Major federal programs selected for audit represented over \$500 million in expenditures reported by the District during the 2013-14 Fiscal Year. Regarding compliance with requirements applicable to each major federal program and on internal control over compliance pursuant to OMB Circular A-133 requirements, for the second year in a row, the Single Audit Report contains an unmodified opinion and no audit findings or recommendations. The administration should be highly commended for such achievement.

The School Board Audit and Budget Advisory Committee reviewed this report at its January 27, 2015, meeting and recommended transmitting it to the School Board.

Copies of this report were previously distributed and placed on file in the Office of the Recording Secretary to the School Board and in the Citizen Information Center. Additional copies will be provided upon request.
