As an artist, Ruth won "Best in Show" from the American Artists Professional League, the Miami Watercolor Society, and the Florida Professional Artists Guild. She is the recipient of over 100 other awards. Many of Ruth's works have been published.

Ruth and her husband realized being in the produce business that there should be more fruit and vegetables served to the students. They came up with the idea of the first salad bar at Miami Beach Senior High School, which is the school their children attended. The salad bar is still there today and has been added to most other high schools. Ruth continues to give art demonstrations in public schools including those classes her grandchildren attend.

Ruth has always been active in her community and takes a stand for what she believes. Ruth was president of the University of Miami Hurricane Club, and she was the first woman to ever hold that position. She and her husband successfully sued a residential club to become members when they weren't allowing Jewish residents of that community to join. Mrs. Karp contributed to Miami's Jewish community and other worthy causes, and to cultural arts programs, and worked for the Miami-Beach Parks and Recreation department.

As Ruth Karp celebrates her 90<sup>th</sup> birthday this month, Miami-Dade County Public Schools recognizes the positive impact she has had on local institutions and people's lives.
