Established in 1996, the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust (Ethics Commission) is an independent agency with advisory and quasi-judicial powers that extends to the municipalities of Miami-Dade County. The Ethics Commission is committed to public education, training, and community outreach.

On May 1 and 2, 2015, the Ethics Commission will hold its first ever "Ethics in Education: A to Z Conference" at the University of Miami, Bank United Center (Hurricane 100 Room), 1245 Dauer Dr., Coral Gables, FL 33146. The two-day conference is for teachers, students, parents, educational administrators and concerned citizens and will cover major ethical issues at all levels of American education. The conference is presented jointly by the Miami-Dade Commission on Ethics and Public Trust, the University of Miami, and the Miami-Dade County Public Schools.
