Procurement Management Services, at the request of School Operations, Alternative Education, released the above-referenced solicitation. The purpose of this Request For Proposal is to provide on-site comprehensive healthcare services to approximately 165 teen parents and their infants/toddlers at COPE Center North, located at 9950 N.W. 19 Avenue, Miami, Florida 33147. This Request For Proposals was advertised on the Procurement Management Services' website, the Demandstar website, The Miami Times and the Diario Las Americas newspapers, Bid Net and Florida Bid, as well as emailed to 85 potential bidders.

The initial term of the RFP shall be for two (2) years, commencing July 15, 2015 through July 14, 2017, and may, by mutual agreement between The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the successful bidder(s), be extended for three (3) additional one (1) year periods, at the District's sole discretion.

A meeting of the Selection Committee was held on May 5, 2015, to evaluate the two (2) proposals received from Jessie Trice Community Health Center, Inc. and Rozalyn H. Paschal M.D. P.A. The district negotiated Best and Final Offers from both Jessie Trice Community Health Center, Inc. and Rozalyn H. Paschal M.D. P.A. After review of the proposals and discussion, the Committee recommended that Rozalyn H. Paschal M.D. P.A., be awarded to provide healthcare services, as the primary awardee, and Jessie Trice Community Health Center, Inc., as the alternate awardee.

The contract shall be awarded to a primary and alternate vendor. Based on criteria listed in the solicitation, two vendors are being recommended for award. The two (2) vendors who responded to this advertised solicitation, one (1) is currently doing business with the District.
