SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE CONTINUATION OF FULL SERVICE SCHOOLS PROGRAM IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND TO ACCEPT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$768,000 EFFECTIVE UPON EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT

The Full Service Schools initiative has been a collaborative project between Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County for 23 years. The Full Service School program provides basic school health services including nutritional services, basic medical services, aid to dependent children, parenting skills, counseling for abused children, counseling for children at high risk for delinquent behavior and their parents, and adult education, as required by Section 402.3026, Florida Statutes.

This board item is to request authorization for the Superintendent of Schools to enter into a contractual agreement with the Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County to provide health services in Full Service Schools Program in Miami-Dade County Public Schools and to accept funds in the amount of \$768,000 effective upon the execution of the contract.

The participating schools are: Biscayne Elementary School; James H. Bright Elementary School; Poinciana Park Elementary School; Miami Park Elementary School; Frederick Douglass Elementary School; Norland Elementary School; Laura C. Saunders Elementary School; Gratigny Elementary School; Phillis Wheatley Elementary School; Toussaint L'Ouverture Elementary School; Shadolawn Elementary School; Dr. Robert Ingram Elementary School; Charles R. Drew K-8; Paul Dunbar K-8; Lillie C. Evans K-8; Madison Middle; Hialeah Senior High; Miami Beach Senior High; and Homestead Senior High.

There is no cost to the District.

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RECOMMENDED: That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent of Schools to enter into a contractual agreement with The Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County for the continuation of the Full Service Schools program in Miami-Dade County Public Schools and to accept the amount of \$768,000, effective upon execution of the contract.
