Young: suspension without pay from his position as Lead Custodian at North Dade Center for Modern Languages, for ten (10) calendar days, effective October 15, 2015, for just cause, including, but not limited to: violation of School Board Policies 4210, Standards of Ethical Conduct; and 4210.01, Code of Ethics. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22 (1)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes; and Articles II and XI of the **Contract between the Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME)**.

Charles J. McDonald: suspension without pay from his position as Custodian at North Dade Center for Modern Languages, for five (5) calendar days, effective October 26, 2015, for just cause, including, but not limited to: violation of School Board Policies 4210, Standards of Ethical Conduct; and 4210.01, Code of Ethics.
