 - a. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under Learning for Life, in the approximate amount of \$412,000, for the grant period of July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016;
 - b. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Adult Education and Family Literacy, Adult General Education, in the approximate amount of \$2,814,113, for the grant period of July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016;
 - c. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Adult Education and Family Literacy, English Literacy & Civics Education, in the approximate amount of \$2,300,000, for the grant period of July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016;
 - d. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) – Extended Learning Time (Liberty City Elementary School), in the approximate amount of \$464,254, for the grant period of July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016;
 - e. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) (Dr. William A. Chapman Elementary), in the approximate amount of \$343,402, for the grant period of August 1, 2015 – July 31, 2016;

- f. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the 21st Century Community Learning Centers, Science, Engineering, Communication, and Mathematics Enhancement (SECME) Stars III, in the approximate amount of \$556,418, for the grant period of August 1, 2015 – July 31, 2016;

 - i. Himan Brown Charitable Trust for funding for the Himan Brown Charitable Trust After-school Care Program, in the approximate amount of \$350,000, for the grant period of July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016.
2. enter into contractual services agreements with the agencies prescribed in the grants, with whom the School Board must contract, pursuant to Board Policy 6320 - Purchase Approval and Competitive Bidding Process Requirements:
 - a. Learning for Life, in the approximate amount of \$412,000.
3. extend these programs and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program;
4. retain funds from the grants in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
5. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board;
6. authorize travel out-of-state as required by the grant parameters; and

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7. upon cessation of the grant funds, any grant-funded position will be eliminated, and the impacted employee(s) will be placed on the Personnel Action Listing of Instructional and Non-Instructional Appointments, Reassignments, Leaves and Separations for the relevant period.

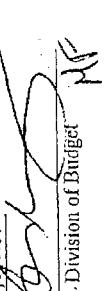
