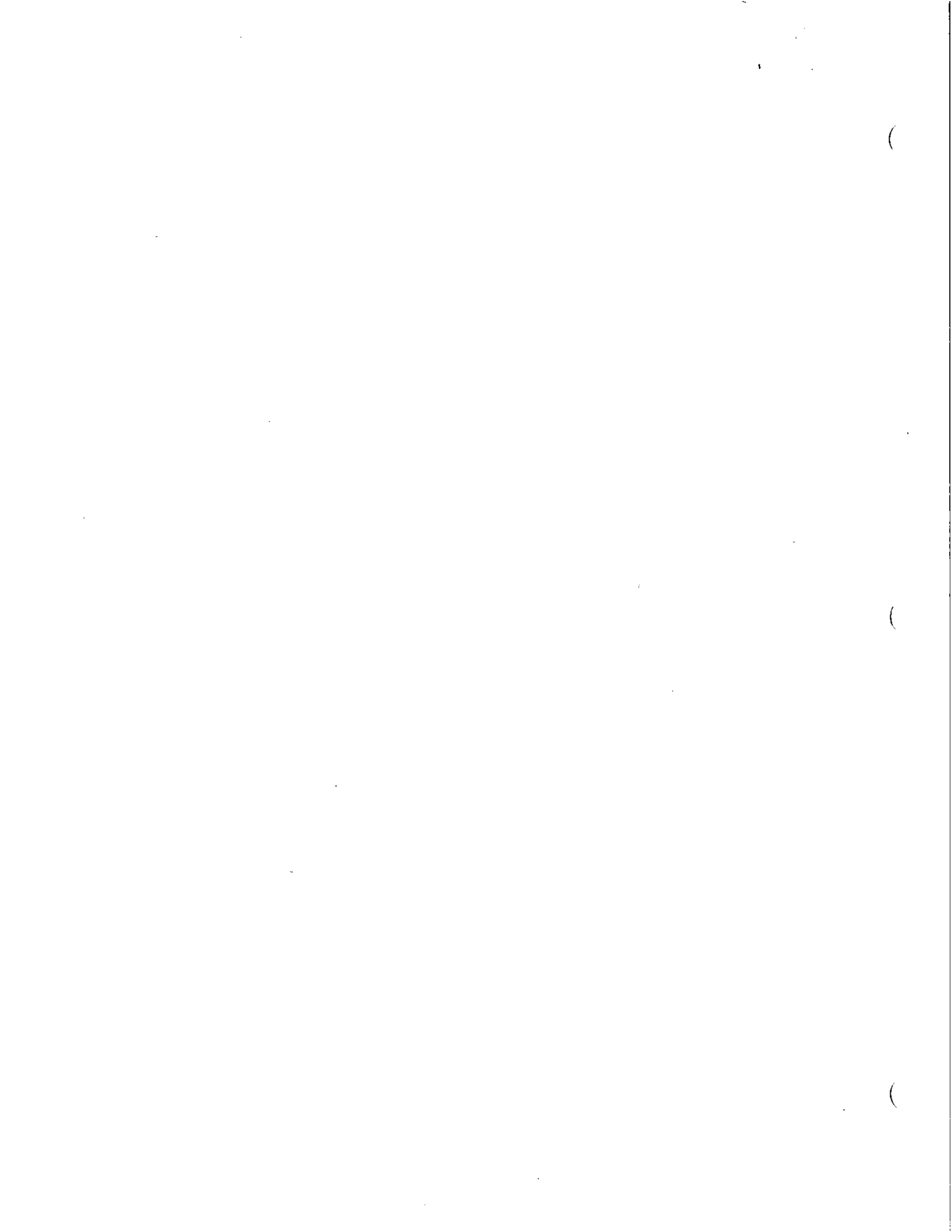
School Board Agenda Item F-37, scheduled for consideration on June 22, 2016, is being withdrawn for further review.

SUBJECT: AWARD TO THORNTON CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. (THORNTON) FOR THE GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND FUNDED NEW K-8 SCHOOL, LOCATED AT N.W. 90 STREET AND N.W. 114 AVENUE, MIAMI, FLORIDA 33178; PROJECT NUMBER 01439300

Introduction

On May 2, 2016 a solicitation was published to competitively bid (Hard Bid) construction of the General Obligation Bond (GOB) funded New K-8 School in the Doral area. Bids have been received and this item provides a recommendation for award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Eleven (11) pre-qualified contractors picked up plans and specifications. A mandatory pre-bid conference was conducted on May 11, 2016 for interested contractors and sub-contractors. Seven (7) sealed bids were received and these were opened on May 31, 2016, at the School Board Administration Building Auditorium. The Project Architect, staff from the Office of Economic Opportunity and Office of School Facilities witnessed the bid opening.

After analysis of the bid tabulation (see Attachment A), it was determined that Thornton was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, with a Base Bid price of \$10,924,976. No deductive alternates are being taken; however, the award amount is being reduced by \$163,875 as a result of sales tax savings generated by the District's Direct Materials Procurement Program. Consequently, District Staff and the Project Architect, Zyscovich Architects, recommend awarding the project to Thornton in the amount of \$10,761,101.

This project comprises the initial (K-5) phase of the school which will later be expanded to a full K-8 configuration. The scope of work for this project includes but is not limited to: construction of new elementary school facility comprised of classrooms, media center, full kitchen, cafeteria, administrative offices, play courts, playfields, student drop-off areas, and various other support spaces. The school is designed for a capacity of 750 student stations.
