Background

School Board Policy 6334, Florida Statutes and State Requirements for Educational Facilities §4 (SREF) require school districts to prequalify contractors prior to bidding construction contracts, construction management, design-build, and any other construction services application for a one (1) year period or for a specific project. The Office of Economic Opportunity and the Contractor Prequalification Review Committee (Committee) administer compliance in accordance with SREF and School Board Policy requirements. The criterion for prequalification is based on the single bid limit amount of the largest successfully completed project of similar size and scope. The aggregate bid limit amount is determined by the company's surety bonding.

On Monday, June 25, 2016, the Committee evaluated and recommended for Board approval one (1) new application for contractor prequalification. (See Attachment "A")
