At its July 13, 2016, meeting, the Board approved Agenda Item G-1 (Student Fundraising), authorizing the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking procedures to amend Policy 5830, *Student Fundraising*, to prohibit students participating in all types of school-approved student fundraising from standing in roadways and roadway medians.

The Notice of Intended Action was published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on July 18, 2016, posted in various places for public information and mailed to various organizations representing persons affected by the new and amended policies and to individuals requesting notification. The time to request a hearing or protest the adoption of these amendments has elapsed.

In accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, the amended policy is presented to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for adoption and authorization to file in the official records of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Attached is the Notice of Intended Action and the proposed new policy and policy amendments. Changes are indicated by underscoring words to be added and ~~striking through~~ words to be deleted.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, amend Policy 5830, *Student Fundraising*, and authorize the Superintendent to file the amended policy with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, to be effective September 7, 2016. }
