**SUBJECT: AWARD INVITATION TO BID NO. ITB-16-021-AC – SOLID  
WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES**

Procurement Management Services, at the request of the Office of School Facilities, released the above-referenced solicitation. The purpose of this Invitation To Bid (ITB) is to establish a contract, at firm unit prices, to provide solid waste collection services for facilities throughout the Miami-Dade County Public Schools. Bidders must have the ability to provide services at various locations throughout the District. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase services, as may be needed, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. This ITB was advertised on the Procurement Management Services website, the Demandstar website, BidNet, Florida Bid, *The Miami Times*, and the *Diario Las Americas* newspapers as well as emailed to 130 potential bidders, which included three (3) MBE vendors that are registered to the solid waste commodity codes.

The initial term of the bid shall be for a period of three (3) years, commencing December 14, 2016, through December 13, 2019, and may, by mutual agreement between The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the successful bidders, be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods.

Strategies were employed to increase SBE/MBE participation. The Goal Setting Committee recommended that this solicitation be open, not sheltered, as a large number of SBE/MBE vendors were not identified within the commodity code(s).

Three (3) vendors responded to this advertised bid. Based on the criteria listed in the solicitation, two (2) primary and one (1) alternate vendor are being recommended for award.
