The State of Florida weathered one of the strongest storms in recorded history with the landfall of Hurricane Irma. As we have resumed normal operations staff has conducted a thorough analysis of the impact of the seven days of school closure on the District's ability to fulfill statutory requirements related to instructional time. Even with the loss of seven instructional days, the District exceeds the minimum instructional hours required by the state.

Section 1011.60(2) of the Florida Statutes indicates that schools must operate for 180 actual teaching days or the equivalent on an hourly basis to participate in the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP). Rule 6A.1.045111 of the Florida Administrative Code provides additional specification regarding the number of instructional hours required for each grade level as not less than 720 hours for kindergarten through grade 3 and not less than 900 hours for grades 4 through 12. Provided that these statutory requirements are met, school boards have the authority to adopt an alternative calendar without authorization or approval by the Florida Department of Education without penalty to their district's FEFP funding or the reporting of full-time equivalent students.

Florida law gives the Commissioner of Education and the State Board of Education the authority to alter the instructional hours requirement when the loss of instructional hours is caused by a bona fide emergency and when it is not feasible to make up the lost days

or hours. Commissioner of Education Pam Stewart advised superintendents across the state that she is authorizing the waiver of up to two days of instructional time as a result of required school closures due to Hurricane Irma. As the district has exceeded the state mandate regarding instructional time, it is not necessary to seek a waiver.

However, the loss of instructional time resulted in impacts to student learning and therefore adjustments to the school calendar are proposed to return valuable instructional time to students and teachers. The proposed changes to the calendars are as follows:

- Five (5) dates are being converted to regular school days on the Revised Elementary and Secondary School Calendar 2017-18. The impacted dates are:
 - January 19, 2018 (previously teacher planning day);
 - February 15, 2018 (previously secondary early release day);
 - o April 19, 2018 (previously secondary early release day);
 - o April 20, 2018 (previously teacher planning day); and
 - May 17, 2018 (previously secondary early release day)
- Two (2) dates are being converted to regular school days on the Revised Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar 2017-18. The impacted dates are:
 - o January 19, 2018 (previously teacher planning day); and
 - April 20, 2018 (previously teacher planning day)
- Five (5) dates are being converted to regular school days on the Revised Juvenile Justice Center School Calendar 2017-18. The impacted dates are:
 - January 19, 2018 (previously-teacher planning day);
 - February 15, 2018 (previously secondary early release day);
 - o April 19, 2018 (previously secondary early release day);
 - o April 20, 2018 (previously teacher planning day); and
 - May 17, 2018 (previously secondary early release day)

Therefore, the revised school calendars presented are keeping in mind solutions that best support learning and are responsive to the community. The following school calendars are presented for approval by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

Revised Elementary and Secondary School Calendar - 2017-2018 which:

- provides 175 days of instruction for students; and
- provides 189 days for teachers (175 days for students, 8 teacher planning days, and six (6) legal holidays).

Revised Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar - 2017-2018, which:

- provides 211 days of instruction for students, and
- provides 227 days for teachers (211 days for students, 10 teacher planning days, and six (6) legal holidays).

Revised Juvenile Justice Center School Calendar – 2017-2018, developed in compliance with Section 1003.01(11)(a) F.S.:

- · provides 233 days of instruction for students; and
- provides 248 days for teachers (233 days for students, 9 teacher planning days, and six (6) legal holidays).

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve:

- 1. the REVISED Elementary and Secondary School Calendar 2017 2018, with a start date of August 21, 2017;
- 2. the REVISED Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar 2017 2018, with a start date of August 21, 2017; and
- 3. the REVISED Juvenile Justice Center School Calendar 2017 2018, with a start date of July 7, 2017






