SUBJECT: REQUEST THAT THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVE THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS (SIPs)

LINK TO STRATEGIC BLUEPRINT: RELEVANT, RIGOROUS, AND INNOVATIVE ACADEMICS

Florida State Statute 1001.42 and the State of Florida's Differentiated Accountability program require that schools that have a school grade of "D" or "F" develop and implement a School Improvement Plan (SIP) which includes specific strategies to improve student performance and address educational priorities.

In 2017-2018, 14 M-DCPS and 23 identified Charter Schools completed a SIP using the State of Florida's Bureau of School Improvement's online SIP template. The 2017-2018 SIPs were developed through a peer review process which included approval by the school-site Educational Excellence School Advisory Council (EESAC), and review and approval by District and Region staff. The Charter School Compliance and Support Office reviewed and provided feedback to the 23 identified charter schools required to submit a SIP.
