At the School Board Meeting of March 9, 2016, Award of Invitation to Bid (ITB) Number ITB-15-032-MT – Auction Services was approved by the School Board and awarded to a primary vendor, Bidera, LLC and a secondary vendor, Govdeals, Inc. The purpose of the ITB was to purchase auction services that may be provided on-site or online.

As per the bid specifications, items to be auctioned are District's surplus items. These items may include but are not limited to vehicles, kitchen equipment, buses and miscellaneous items. All items disposed are pursuant to and in compliance with School Board Policy 7310, Disposition of Surplus Equipment.

District staff, including members from the different offices within the Financial Services Bureau, as well as members from the Office of Management and Compliance Audits met with the awarded vendor, Bidera LLC, to develop a streamlined process of registering the items for auction, completing the auction and submitting the auction report and proceeds to the District. All auctions were conducted online, giving the District access to the vendor's national network of bidders.

Auction results and proceeds are included in the Mid-Year General Fund budget resolution, E-14 dated February 15, 2017. Auction proceeds are non-recurring funds from the sale of capital assets.
