Background:

At its meeting of October 14, 2015 (Item F-30) the Board commissioned Thornton Construction Company, Inc. (Thornton), as the Construction Management At-Risk (CMR) firm for the new addition, renovations and repairs at Arcola Lake Elementary School. As part of their pre-construction services, Thornton has worked closely with the project Architect in developing Construction Documents by providing scheduling, asbuilt verification, constructability reviews and cost estimating services. This project is for the construction, renovation and repair of portions of the existing facility, and various site improvements. This contract provides a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for construction to the Board.

On December 1, 2016, ninety-three (93) sealed subcontractor bids were received and opened at the School Board Administration Building. The Project Architect and staff from the Office of School Facilities Construction witnessed the bid opening and tabulation process. Negotiations with Thornton concluded successfully and the GMP agreed to for this project is \$3,343,811, which includes an Owner's contingency of \$142,684. This contract covers all required work and includes subcontracts, materials, contingency, general conditions, bonds, overhead and profit.

The contract provides for compliance with Small and Micro Businesses Utilization Goals.

The M-DCPS Office of Economic Opportunity staff reviewed the S/MBE and M/WBE certification status of all subcontractors and verified the existence of a Letter of Intent for each, outlining roles and responsibilities.

Description and Scope

Existing Campus:

Arcola Lake Elementary School is located at 1037 N.W. 81 Street, Miami, Florida. The facility is bordered on the south by Northwest 81 Street, on the west by Northwest 11 Avenue, on the east by a single family residential area, and on the north by Northwest 83 Street. The existing school was built in 1969 with additions constructed afterwards, and is currently comprised of seven (7) permanent buildings situated on an approximately 8.75-acre parcel of land. The facility will have a permanent capacity of 708 student stations once project is completed.

Project Scope:

The proposed scope of work for this project includes, but is not limited to: demolition of existing portable; demolition of existing Building #3 including connected covered walkway; new Building #3 approximately 11,850 square feet with 10 ESE classrooms including restrooms; 4 ESE supplemental rooms; a Health Clinic with restroom, shower and associated support space; mechanical upgrades; electrical upgrades; new covered walkway leading to new Building #3 entrance; full exterior painting, and miscellaneous improvements throughout.
