In accordance with Florida Statute 1006.40(5), school boards must approve and adopt instructional materials prior to purchase. A public review was made available via the School Board's website beginning on May 1, 2017, and a public hearing was held to receive public comment at the School Board meeting on May 24, 2017. Instructional materials were selected in compliance with School Board Policy 2510 and the School Board's instructional materials adoption procedures.
