SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR STUDENTS TO TRAVEL OUT-OF-COUNTRY

Requests have been received for students to travel out-of-country. All arrangements are in accordance with the *School Board Policy 2340 - Field and Other District-Sponsored Trips and with the School Board Policy 8640 – Transportation for Field and Other District-Sponsored Trips*. The State Department alerts U.S. citizens to possible risks of travel due to increased threats. There is always the possibility that a change in the travel alert level may occur prior to a trip. When there is a travel warning, the affected trips will not be allowed to take place.

Additionally, Miami-Dade County Public Schools will be receiving 40 scholarships for students selected by the Superintendent, as part of a five-year agreement with EF Educational Tours, valued at \$148,750.00. Forty students and six chaperones will have the opportunity to travel to Barcelona and Madrid, Spain during the Summer of 2018. This trip will bring the classroom to life by providing students the opportunity to be exposed to sites and cultures they have studied through various curricula, an opportunity that otherwise might not have been available to them.
