- NUTTING ENGINEERS OF FLORIDA, INC.

Background

Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc. was commissioned by the Board on May 8, 2013, to provide Program Management Support Services (PMSS) to assist in the delivery of Districtwide school renovations, replacements and technology upgrades under the \$1.2 Billion General Obligation Bond (GOB). At the October 11, 2017, Board Meeting, the PMSS firm's name change was authorized by the Board to WSP USA Inc. (WSP).

The District's Geotechnical, Construction Materials Testing & Environmental Assessment Services (Geotech) Agreements expired in July 2017. In support of the ongoing GOB program, the District requested that WSP add one or more Geotech sub-consultants to the PMSS Agreement to provide these critically necessary services, as soon as possible.

WSP is requesting authorization to add the following three firms:

- AMEC Foster Wheeler Environment & Infrastructure, Inc.
- Nutting Engineers of Florida, Inc.
- Professional Service Industries, Inc.

Summary and Recommendation

Article I of the PMSS Agreement sets out the parameters for addition of sub-consultants, and Article IV, paragraph 4.12.1, specifies compensation for such services.

WSP submitted current documentation to support the request for the addition of the three subject Geotech firms. Staff has reviewed the documentation, found it to be acceptable, and recommends the Board's authorization.

RECOMMENDED:

That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida authorize the addition of the following Geotechnical and Construction Materials Testing & Environmental Assessment Services Sub-consultants to the Program Management Support Services Agreement with WSP USA Inc., in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement:

- Nutting Engineers of Florida, Inc.
- Professional Service Industries, Inc.

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
