#### **NEW AND AMENDED CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACTS**

<sup>\*</sup>Pursuant to s.1002.33, F.S., "high performing" is a designation, made by the Commission of Education for certain charter schools that allows them to increase enrollment, expand grade levels, submit quarterly rather than monthly financial reports, consolidate charters, and/or modify charter term up to 15 years. Recent changes in legislation also allow a high-performing charter school to increase enrollment beyond the contract capacity, but not to exceed the capacity of the facility at the time enrollment will take effect.

#### **CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT RENEWALS**

Section 1002.33(7)(b), F.S., states that a charter may be renewed provided that a program review demonstrates that the significant components of the charter application have been successfully accomplished and that none of the following grounds for nonrenewal/termination have been established: (1) failure to participate in the state's education accountability system or failure to meet the requirements for students performance stated in the charter; (2) failure to meet generally accepted standards of fiscal management; (3) violation of law; and/or (4) other good cause.

Additional details for the renewal contract can be found in Attachment "C", which is provided under separate cover but is included and incorporated by reference in this Board item. The recommendation for the charter school contract renewal included in this item is as follows:

#### **DISTRICT IMPACT**

Any significant increase in charter school student enrollment (Charter FTE) directly impacts the District's operating budget as well as instructional and non-instructional staffing levels. The new contracts being presented represent an increase in overall charter school enrollment and an anticipated initial loss to the District for the 2018-2019 SY.

To ensure that the District's financial position remains positive, Board authorization is requested to allow a Reduction-in-Force/Layoff only if it becomes necessary. Any such Reduction-in-Force/Layoff affecting instructional and non-instructional staff would be implemented in accordance with School Board policies and applicable collective bargaining agreements. The number of position reductions will not exceed the stated Initial Loss included in this item and will be re-evaluated and adjusted in subsequent years to reflect changes in FTE. Additional information on the impact is provided in Attachments "A" and "B".

They were also informed of the School Board's Personnel, Student, School and Community Support Committee Meeting and procedures for requesting to appear before the School Board at meetings and public hearings.

Copies of the contracts have been transmitted to the School Board Members under separate cover and will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary, Room 924, and in the Citizen Information Center, Room 158, 1450 N.E. Second Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132.

Board approval of this item does not reflect or constitute a finding of need, justification, or endorsement for any charter school as proposed in the item but only that it meets the statutory requirements for Board approval of a charter school application or contract under Section 1002.33, F.S., and School Board Policy, 9800, *Charter Schools*.

- A. Approve one new charter school contract with Somerset Academy, Inc., d/b/a Somerset Academy Sunset, to (a) approve an initial charter contract for a 5-year term and, (b) change the school's name from Somerset Academy Sunset to Somerset Academy Kendall commencing July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2023.
- B. Approve six charter school contract amendments with:
  - New Alternative Education High School of Miami-Dade, Inc., d/b/a C.G. Bethel High School (MSID 7062), to approve (a) the merger of New Alternative Education High School of Miami-Dade, Inc., New Alternative Education High School of Broward County, Inc., and New Alternative Education High School of Palm Beach County, Inc., and, (b) the name change of the legal entity from New Alternative Education High School of Miami-Dade, Inc., to NorthStar Academies, Inc., d/b/a C.G. Bethel High School commencing July 26, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019;

- Somerset Academy, Inc., d/b/a Somerset Academy (MSID 3. 0520), to (a) for the satellite campus, modify the grade level configuration and enrollment to Kindergarten and First Grade only, with a maximum enrollment of 216 students, for the 2018-19 School Year (thereby increasing the overall maximum enrollment to 1,021 students) and Kindergarten to Second Grade with a maximum of 305 students only, during the 2019-20 school year (thereby increasing the overall maximum enrollment to 1,110 students); (b) close and cease operations of the satellite campus by June 30, 2020 and revert the enrollment back to the maximum capacity of 805 students; (c) for students enrolled and attending the satellite campus, establish an additional administrative fee to be paid to the Sponsor in the same manner as the fee paid for the Main Campus; (d) require the School to execute and maintain documentation of the Satellite Campus Parent Acknowledgement Form; and (e) require the School to maintain documentation of student registration, student daily attendance, and class schedules for students housed at the satellite campus.
- 4. Somerset Academy, Inc., d/b/a Somerset Academy (Silver Palms) (MSID 0332), under Section 1002.331(2), F.S., **High-Performing Charter Schools**, to increase the student enrollment by 735 students a maximum enrollment of 2,000 students, commencing July 26, 2018, and ending June 30, 2032;
- 5.
