<u>Introduction</u>

On May 21, 2018, a solicitation was published to competitively bid (Hard Bid) construction of Phase I of the General Obligation Bond (GOB) funded Norland Middle School project. Bids have been received and this item provides a recommendation for award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Nine (9) pre-qualified contractors picked up plans and specifications. A mandatory pre-bid conference was conducted on June 5, 2018, for interested contractors and sub-contractors. Five (5) sealed bids were received and these were opened on June 26, 2018, at the School Board Administration Building Auditorium. The District staff from the Office of School Facilities and the Project Architect witnessed the bid opening.

After analysis of the bid tabulation (see Attachment A), it was determined that E.L.C.I. Construction Group, Inc. (E.L.C.I.) was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, with a Base Bid price of \$3,238,220.68. No deductive alternates are being taken; however, the award amount is being reduced by \$64,764.42 as a result of sales tax savings generated by the District's Direct Materials Procurement Program. Consequently, District staff and the Project Architect, Wolfberg Alvarez & Partners, recommend awarding the project to E.L.C.I. in the amount of \$3,173,456.26.

The contract provides for compliance with Small/Micro Business Enterprise (S/MBE) and Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) utilization goals. The Office of School Facilities Construction staff reviewed the S/MBE and M/WBE certification status of all subcontractors (see Attachment B) and verified the existence of a Letter of Intent for each, outlining roles and responsibilities. The S/MBE and M/WBE information has also been validated by the Office of Economic Opportunity (OEO).

Small/Micro Business Enterprise (S/MBE) Utilization:

A mandatory S/MBE participation goal of 21.57%, for Construction, was established for this project (as determined by the M-DCPS Goal Setting Committee).

Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) Utilization:

A mandatory M/WBE goal of 3.43%, African American, was established for this project (as determined by the M-DCPS Goal Setting Committee).

Identified below are the S/MBE and M/WBE firms that E.L.C.I. will use on the project. Additional S/MBE and/or M/WBE subcontractors may be included in the project as the contractor finalizes awarding of all the subcontracts.

OEO staff confirmed the SBE/MBE and M/WBE Certification status of the prime firm and each sub-contractor, and verified the Participation Letters of Intent outlining roles and responsibilities. The following table details firms that E.L.C.I. will use on the project:

Local Workforce Utilization:

E.L.C.I. will provide a Local Workforce Utilization of 20% for Construction, within a 5-mile radius of the project (as determined by the M-DCPS Goal Setting Committee).

The Office of Economic Opportunity shall monitor the above-stated goals for compliance.

Description and Scope

Existing Campus:

Norland Middle School is located at 1235 N.W. 192 Terrace, Miami Gardens, Florida. The facility is bordered on the north by Northwest 195 Street, on the east by Northwest 12 Avenue, on the west by Northwest 13 Court, and on the south by Northwest 192 Terrace. The existing school buildings were constructed in 1959, with various subsequent additions, and currently comprises ten (10) permanent buildings situated on an approximately 13-acre parcel of land. The facility has a permanent capacity of 1,417 student stations and will expand to a total capacity of 1,439 student stations once the project is completed.

Project Scope:

The proposed scope of work for this project includes: construction of a new Little Theatre/Black Box Building, new covered main entrance and plaza, new pre-engineered Physical Education shelter, partial exterior and interior renovation at Building #5, partial interior renovations at Building #1, selective exterior painting at Building #2, parking modifications at existing parking lots along the South and East sides of the campus, new fencing, new pre-engineered outdoor dining tensile structure, new courtyard, new walkway connections and related sitework, landscaping, drainage and irrigation systems upgrades and miscellaneous upgrades throughout.

(Note: a second GOB project addressing the remainder of the campus is currently in the design phase)
