Anthony Damato began his business career in New York at the age of 18 as a business owner of a contracting company. He then became Director of Operations for KB Electronics and 17 years later, Mr. Damato moved into the auto industry. Mr. Damato has received numerous accolades. He is a three time recipient of the prestigious STARS from Toyota Motor Corp as a Top 14 Sales Professional. He is the first person ever to receive this award their first year in the car business. Additionally, he is a Toyota Top 10 PRO and a five year winner of the Toyota Sales Society Platinum Award.

Mr. Damato is an active member of the community contributing to various organizations throughout Miami-Dade County. He is a partner with Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS), where each year, he provides a 3 year lease for M-DCPS' Principal of The Year and AFSCME Support Personnel of the Year. Additionally, his VIP Toyota Sale program provided M-DCPS employees, family and friends the opportunity to support education and he has donated over \$300 to teacher's classrooms and \$200 the Foundation for New Education Initiatives.
