SUBJECT: REVIEW OF AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR 26 OF 130 CHARTER SCHOOLS AND THREE (3) COMMUNITY BASED ORGANIZATIONS (CBOs) OPERATING DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2018

At its February 5, 2019, meeting, the School Board Audit and Budget Advisory Committee (the Committee or ABAC) were presented with the June 30, 2018, certified financial statements of the following 26 charter schools and three Community Based Organizations (CBOs) and recommended their transmission to the School Board.

Of the 26 charter schools listed above, 23 were free of significant fiscal issues, while three disclosed fiscal concerns. Specifically, at *Arts Academy of Excellence* and according to the external audit firm, the School met the definition of a deteriorating financial condition pursuant to Section 218.39(5)(b), Florida Statutes. The School has been notified of this condition and has commenced development of a corrective action plan. At Chambers High School and C.G. Bethel High School, the external auditors identified a deficiency in the internal controls which they determined to be a material weakness. Specifically, they noted that federal funds were received by the former management company on behalf of Chambers High School and C.G. Bethel High School, but not advanced to the school.



Three Community Based Organizations (CBOs)

All three CBOs were found to be financially sound.
