Pursuant to provisions of the labor contract between Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the Dade County School Maintenance Employee Committee (DCSMEC), the parties commenced 2018-2021 Successor Contract negotiations on October 24, 2018 and reached a Tentative Agreement on February 28, 2019.

The major highlights of the Tentative Agreement are as follows:

- Provides salary adjustments effective July 1, 2018.
- Increases in Health Insurance costs will be absorbed by the District and a free option continues to be available for all employees.

The Tentative Agreement was ratified by DCSMEC unit members on March 7, 2019.

Copies of the Tentative Agreement and the 2019 Employee Benefit Program MOU have been forwarded to Board Members under separate cover and will be placed on file in the Citizen Information Center and the Board Recording Secretary's Office.

This item does not appear on the published Agenda. There exists good cause to vary from the published Agenda as the agreement with M-DCPS and DCSMEC had not been ratified by DCSMEC prior to the publication of the Agenda.
