Currently, SAS has five campuses (Homestead, Kendall, North, West and Wolfson), and has over 760 students spanning the entire district. SAS provides a uniquely supportive transition between secondary and post-secondary education with 100% of its scholars earning an Associate in Arts degree and high school diploma concurrently each year achieving SAS's mission of enabling highly motivated students to achieve their academic and personal potential through an accelerated, full-time high school dual-enrollment program in a college setting.

SAS's opportunity for acceleration and enrichment attracts motivated and academically talented students and, through their vision of committing to a comprehensive academic program which will enable our students to become ethical, productive, and active members of society, has produced some of the most academically accomplished scholars. SAS attributes strong core values, visionary leadership and extraordinary faculty and staff.
