**SUBJECT:           REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH COMMUNITY AGENCIES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND NUTRITION TO PROVIDE AFTERSCHOOL MEALS/SNACKS FOR PARTICIPANTS IN THEIR PROGRAMS FROM AUGUST 19, 2019 THROUGH AUGUST 19, 2022.**

Through approved contractual agreements with community agencies, the District provides afterschool meals and snack services to students enrolled in afterschool programs in our schools. The Superintendent of Schools requests authorization to enter into agreements with the following community agencies to provide afterschool meals/snacks to student participants in their programs commencing in the 2019-2020 school year. The contractual agreements outline the agency’s responsibility for accountability to receive the afterschool meal/snack service for student participants, as required by the Department of Food and Nutrition to claim federal reimbursements, the contracts are for up to a 3-year time period August 19, 2019 through August 19, 2022.

The Department of Food and Nutrition works closely with the Office of Community Education and Before/After School Programs to inform afterschool providers in district facilities of the afterschool meals/snacks program. In addition, afterschool program providers may be referred to the Department of Food and Nutrition to request meals/snacks services by state or local agencies. Accordingly, authorization is also requested for the Superintendent to contract with other agencies conducting afterschool programs in our schools that may be added during this school year. The Board will be notified throughout the school year of additional contracts that may be issued for this purpose.
