The scope of Informed Families' work is in universal, targeted and selected substance use prevention and parent mobilization. School-based universal prevention programs facilitated by Informed Families, such as Red Ribbon Week, Lock Your Meds, Safe Homes Smart Parties, and Family Day aim to educate, enable and empower students, parents, and communities to work together to keep children healthy. They structure programming, prevention messages and campaigns to include evidence-based interventions and published data regarding the risk and protective factors influencing youth substance use. Informed Families has been in the business of creating positive changes in the behavioral health of families, schools and communities for more than 35 years.

As one of the original Executive Committee members, President and CEO Peggy Sapp helped transform the six volunteer organization into a multimillion dollar agency with state and national outreach. Mrs. Sapp is a recognized leader in drug prevention through grassroots involvement and is the recipient of numerous honors and community service awards. She has served on the Advisory Councils of The White House Office of National Drug Control Policy, the National Institute of Drug Abuse and the Florida Governor's Drug Control Policy Council and is the volunteer President of the National Family Partnership, a national network of parenting organizations.
