Of the 44 charters schools listed in the preceding table, ten charter schools appeared to be free of significant fiscal issues. The certified financial statements of the remaining 34 charter schools include the close-out audits of the three ASPIRA charter schools¹ and other charter schools with fiscal issues or concerns of different magnitudes that we are bringing to the Audit and Budget Advisory Committee for their information, discussion and recommendations to the School Board.

In addition, we will be presenting the close-out audit of Florida International Academy Charter School (FIA) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2018. Although FIA voluntarily terminated its charter agreement and ceased operations as of June 30, 2018, the close-out financial statement audit was not performed at the required time due to a lack of funds.

The audit, which was recently completed and submitted to the District, includes a financial statement audit and the federal Single Audit. The federal Single Audit contains two findings concerning the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program; however, according to the external auditor, there are no questioned costs associated with these findings.

The School Board Audit and Budget Advisory Committee reviewed these reports at its December 3, 2019, meeting and recommended transmission to the School Board.
