Authorization is requested to accept one grant award and four donations in accordance with Budget Summary Forms, Attachments 1.a. through 1.b., for the approximate total of \$2,887,275, as follows:

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept one grant award and four donations from:
  - a. CareerSource South Florida for funding under the Summer Youth Internship Program (SYIP), in the approximate amount of \$1,500,000, for the grant period of April 1, 2020, through September 30, 2020;
  - b. GENYOUth for funding under the Florida Super School Breakfast Initiative, in the approximate amount of \$147,000, and for equipment and resources valued at \$273,175, for the grant period of August 1, 2020, through July 31, 2023;
  - c. iAero Group for in-kind support of equipment valued in the approximate amount of \$640,000;
  - d. Miami Dolphins for funding under Values Matter Miami, in the approximate amount of \$100,100, for the grant period of July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020; and
  - e. Friends of the Bass Museum, Inc. for funding under the Miami Beach Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) Plus Program, in the approximate

amount of \$382,000, for the grant period of October 1, 2019, through September 30, 2020.

2. enter into contractual service agreements with the agencies prescribed in the grant, with whom the School Board must contract, pursuant to Board Policy 6320 – Purchase Approval and Competitive; Bidding Process Requirements;
3. extend these programs and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program;
4. retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
5. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amount approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board;
6. authorize travel out-of-state as required by the grant parameters; and
7. eliminate any grant-funded position upon cessation of the grant funds, and place the impacted employee(s) on the Personnel Action Listing of Instructional and Non-Instructional Appointments, Reassignments, Leaves and Separations for the relevant period.
