It is important to disclose that none of the 59 charter schools in this group met a condition of a financial emergency or a deteriorating financial condition as of June 30, 2019, and therefore no formal corrective or oversight action is mandated by Section 1002.345, Florida Statutes.

Of the 59 charter schools in this group, 37 were free of significant fiscal issues. The certified financial statements of the remaining 22 charter schools disclosed that the external auditor's report indicated one or more findings in the individual charter school's Management Letter. In these instances, charter school management provided corrective actions responsive to the issues. Regarding the three CBOs, we found that the certified financials are financially sound.

The School Board Audit and Budget Advisory Committee will review these financial statements at its May 12, 2020, meeting to consider its transmission to the School Board.
