Many of these leaders serve capably as Principals at school campuses throughout the county and work arduously to ensure educational opportunities and access are afforded to their students and school communities. Two such leaders have honorably served their school communities within District 9 and have succeeded in successfully cultivating school cultures that support high expectations and a nurturing environment for all students. Mr. Thomas Ennis has been a part of the Miami-Dade County Public School system both as a teacher and administrator during his educational career. Mr. Ennis graduated from Western Kentucky University with a B.S. in Education, followed by a Masters of Science in Sports Management, and Educational Leadership Certification from Nova Southeastern University. Ennis has served as principal at Miami Killian High School, Miami Springs High School, and Cutler Ridge Middle School. Mr. Ennis has served as the Principal of Coral Reef Senior High since 2015. The school, with more than 3,400 students, is known as Miami's "Mega- Magnet."

These two outstanding educators are to be commended for their commitment and dedication to excellence on behalf of the students and families of M-DCPS.
