Authorization is requested to accept three grant awards and three donations in accordance with Budget Summary Forms, Attachments 1.a. through 1.c., for the approximate total of \$13,518,843, as follows:

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept three grant awards and three donations from:
 - a. Early Learning Coalition (ELC) for funding under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act: Reopening Support Grant, in the approximate amount of \$310,500, for the grant period of April 1, 2020, through April 30, 2021;
 - b. United States Department of Education (USDOE) for funding under the CARES Act: Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) – Fund for the Improvement of Postsecondary Education (FIPSE) – D.A. Dorsey Technical College, in the approximate amount of \$448,884, for the grant period of November 6, 2020, through November 5, 2021;
 - c. United States Department of Education (USDOE) for funding under the Education Innovation and Research (EIR) Program – Early-Phase Grants, in the approximate amount of \$12,000,000, for the grant period of January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2025;
 - d. Miami-Dade County under the Defense for Tots Boxes program, for in-kind support in the approximate amount of \$150,657, for the grant period of August 31, 2020, through June 9, 2021;
 - e. Miami Beach Senior High School Parent Teacher Student Association under the Miami Beach Senior High School Courtyard Beautification Project, for in-kind support in the approximate amount of \$60,000, for the grant period of March 1, 2021, through August 30, 2021; and
 - f. Children’s Home Society of Florida under the Community School Grant Program, for in-kind support in the approximate amount of \$548,802, for the grant period of July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021.
2. enter into contractual service agreements with the agencies prescribed in the grant, with whom the School Board must contract, pursuant to Board Policy 6320 – Purchase Approval and Competitive; Bidding Process Requirements:
 - a. RMC Research, in the approximate amount of \$1,200,000, in

support of the Education Innovation and Research (EIR) – Early-Phase Grant; and

- b. Learning Policy Institute, in the approximate amount of \$50,000, in support of the Education Innovation and Research – Early Phase Grant;
3. extend these programs and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program;
4. retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
5. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amount approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board;
6. authorize travel out-of-state as required by the grant parameters; and
7. eliminate any grant-funded position upon cessation of the grant funds, and place the impacted employee(s) on the Personnel Action Listing of Instructional and Non-Instructional Appointments, Reassignments, Leaves and Separations for the relevant period.
