○ College-level Studies

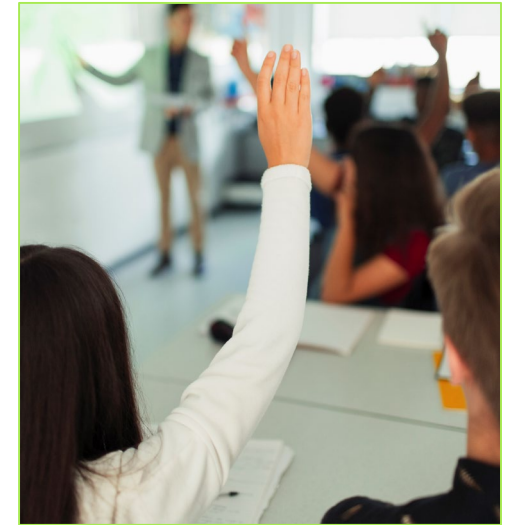
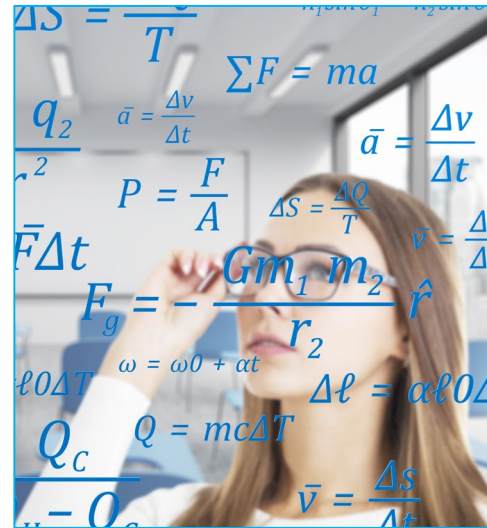
- 38 courses in several subject areas including:

○ College Credit

- Students must receive a score of 3 or higher on a 5-point scale on the corresponding AP exam.
- Over 3,800 universities and colleges worldwide grant college credit or advanced placement to students who have performed satisfactorily on the exams.

Hispanic Subgroup

- Increased by 15 percentage points
 - 2015 – 50%
 - 2020 – 65%

African-American Subgroup

- Increased by 14 percentage points
 - 2015 – 29%
 - 2020 – 43%

Cost Savings to Students and Families

Based on students' opportunity to earn at least three college credits for each AP exam score of 3 or higher, the 2020 passing rate in M-DCPS represents an estimated 97,350 college credits.

At an average rate of \$212.33 per credit hour, the total potential cost savings for Miami-Dade's students and families was \$20,670,325.
