SUBJECT:REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF THE 2020-2022M-DCPS SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES PLAN

Section 381.0056, Florida Statutes, requires each local county health department to develop, jointly with the school District and the School Health Advisory committee, a school health plan. The plan outlines the provisions and responsibilities to provide mandated health services in all public schools. Chapter 64F-6.002, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) requires the plan to be completed biennially and reviewed annually. The final plans and reports are used throughout the year for annual and ad hoc reports to the legislature and the general public.

Additionally, as a part of school board policy 2410 – SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES *PROGRAM*, The District, the local school health advisory council, and the Miami-Dade County Health Department shall jointly develop a school health services plan. The plan shall be completed biennially. Upon recommendation of the Superintendent, the plan shall be submitted to the Board for approval. Following Board approval, the plan shall be signed by the Superintendent and School Board Chairperson, County Health Department medical director or administrator and the district administrator of the County Health Department.

The plan shall be reviewed each year for the purpose of updating the plan. Amendments to the plan shall be submitted to the Board for approval and signed by the Superintendent and the County Health Department medical director or administrator. The services provided shall be dependent on the statutory requirements, local priorities, and availability of resources.

The 2020-2022 school health plan has been developed and approved by the county health department, the Children's Trust who represents public/private partnership and the School Health Advisory Committee.

The plan in its entirety will be submitted under separate cover.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the 2020-2022 School Health Services Plan for Miami-Dade County.
