Authorization is requested to accept four grant awards and one donation in accordance with Budget Summary Forms, Attachments 1.a. through 1.d., for the approximate total of \$113,601,439, as follows:

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept four grant awards and one donation from:
 - a. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Coronavirus Prevention and Response (Sanitation and Cleaning), in the approximate amount of \$3,929,040, for the grant period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021;
 - b. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) Renewal – Dr. William A. Chapman Elementary School, in the approximate amount of \$476,989, for the grant period of

January 1, 2021, through July 31, 2022;

- c. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) Renewal – Downtown Miami Charter School, in the approximate amount of \$471,528, for the grant period of January 1, 2021, through July 31, 2022;
 - d. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under K-12 Civic Literacy Booklist, in the approximate amount of \$523,882, for the grant period of December 18, 2020, through June 30, 2022; and
 - e. T-Mobile for in-kind support under the Project 10Million, in the approximate amount of \$108,200,000, for the grant period of April 1, 2021, through March 31, 2030.
- 2. purchase additional data for the devices donated by T-Mobile as needed through the utilization of other available funds (grant or donated funds), in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000; **ADDED**
 - 3. enter into contractual service agreements with the agencies prescribed in the grant, with whom the School Board must contract, pursuant to Board Policy 6320 – Purchase Approval and Competitive; Bidding Process Requirements;
 - 4. extend these programs and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program;
 - 5. retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
 - 6. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amount approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board;
 - 7. authorize travel out-of-state as required by the grant parameters; and
 - 8. eliminate any grant-funded position upon cessation of the grant funds, and place the impacted employee(s) on the Personnel Action Listing of Instructional and Non-Instructional Appointments, Reassignments, Leaves and Separations for the relevant period.
