

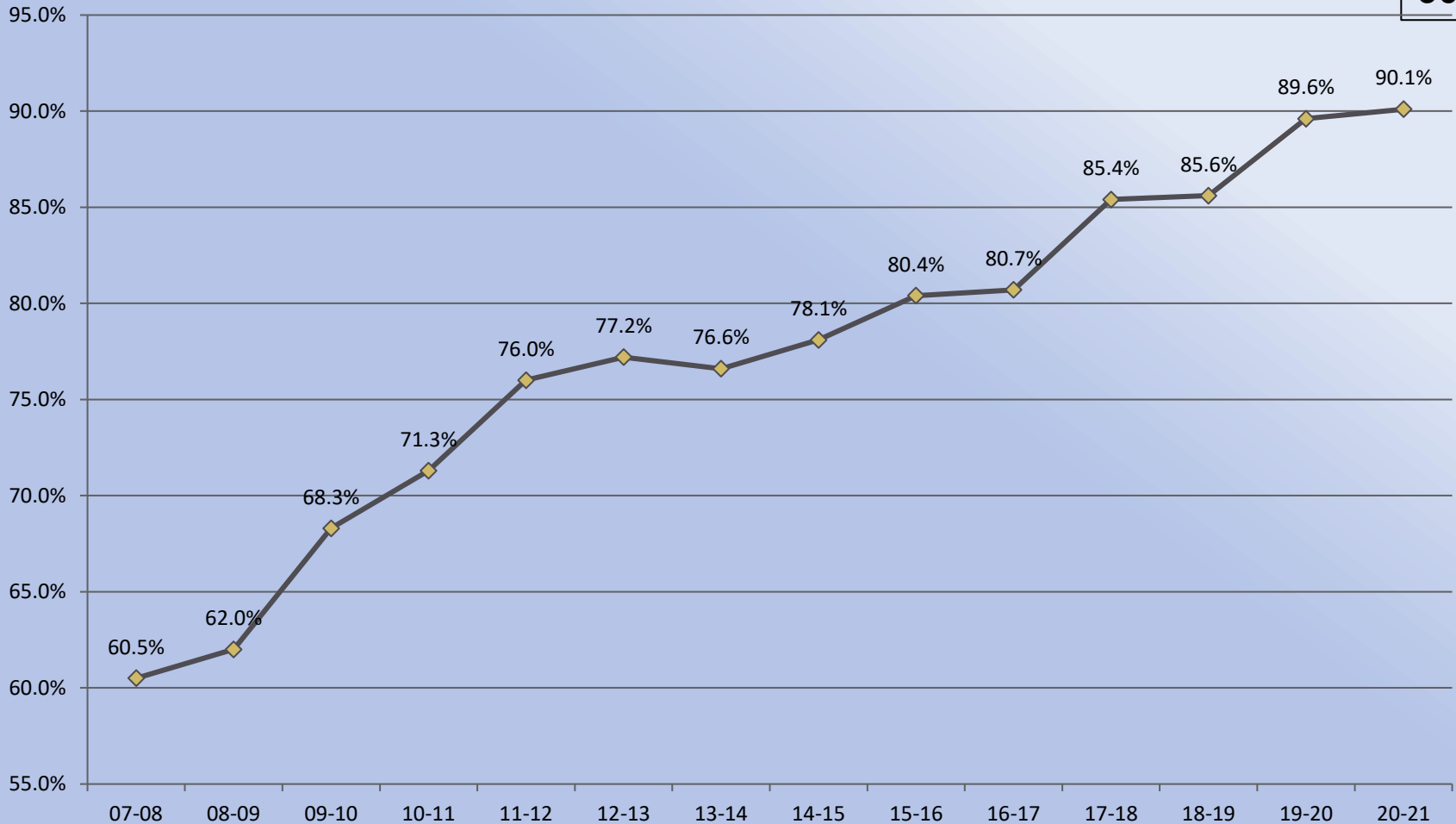

The Bottom Line for the 2020-2021 Graduation Rates

- M-DCPS' graduation rate has reached an all-time high of 90.1 percent for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- Miami-Dade County's graduation rate has increased over 31 percentage points from 58.7 percent in 2006-2007 to 90.1 percent in 2020-2021.
- Miami-Dade County's graduation rate computed excluding charter schools is at **94.0** percent.
