**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF STRUCTURED CABLING SOLUTIONS, INC.,
PURSUANT TO PROCEDURES FOR SANCTIONS UNDER
SCHOOL BOARD POLICY 6320.04 – CONTRACTOR DISCIPLINE**

Pursuant to School Board Policy 6320.04, *Contractor Discipline*, Procurement Management Services, at the request of Information Technology Services, convened the Contractor Disciplinary Review Committee (“CDRC”) on December 9, 2021, to review Structured Cabling Solutions, Inc.’s eligibility to conduct business with the District for failure to comply with the background screening requirements set forth under its contract with the School Board as per ITB-19-003-DP, Wiring. The recommending department may request that the CDRC suspend a company and/or person’s eligibility from doing business with the School Board if the company or person violates any provision of any agreement that the company and/or person entered into with the District.

After reviewing the evidence presented to the CDRC, the CDRC voted to suspend Structured Cabling Solutions, Inc. (“SCS”) from conducting business with the District for a period of eighteen (18) months, as follows:

18-month suspension, effective May 11, 2021 when the Notice of Default and Termination was sent to SCS by Procurement Management Services. Upon request by SCS, the CDRC may consider reducing the suspension period after 12 months, on the condition that SCS provides a satisfactory plan of action to avoid future violations of Jessica Lunsford Act provisions.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, suspend STRUCTURED CABLING SOLUTIONS, INC. from conducting business with the District for a period of eighteen (18) months, under the terms and conditions set forth hereinabove.

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
