Background

The Board, at its meeting of April 21, 2021, approved agenda item Revised H-3, sponsored by Board Member Luisa Santos, and with all other Board Members joining as co-sponsors, adopting Resolution No. 20-010, Acknowledging the Urgency of Achieving 100% Clean Energy Use By 2030 For Better Student Health And Financially Responsible Stewardship, and directing the Superintendent to establish the M-DCPS Clean Energy 2030 task force ("Task Force") through a transparent process inclusive of community members and relevant stakeholder groups, for the purpose of conducting a review of current sustainability measures across all departments, and developing policy recommendations, accountability processes and an implementation plan. The Task Force presented a preliminary report to the Facilities and Construction Committee on December 15, 2021, and has now completed development of the report.
