The “2022 Miami International Agriculture, Horse & Cattle Show”, held the 15th annual event, from April 8-10, 2022, at the Ronald Reagan Equestrian Center, Tropical Park.

The Miami International Agriculture, Horse & Cattle Show was created by Miami-Dade County Commissioner, Senator Javier D. Souto. Since the inaugural event in 2008, this event has been a resounding success in our community, attracting an unprecedented average of 50,000 visitors along with trade missions and representatives from various countries that participate in the agriculture and cattle exposition every year. The event attracts agri-business interests from Latin America, the Caribbean, Europe, Asia, and Australia.

Miami-Dade County’s Agricultural industry is one the most diverse in the county. Employing more than 15,000 people and producing more than \$2.5 billion in economic impact a year. The county also ranks second in the State in the value of agricultural products and 22nd in the nation. It is also home to a vibrant equestrian industry, with its own unique area located in the Southwest part of the county, known as Horse Country.

Through a partnership with the Miami International Agriculture, Horse & Cattle Show and Miami-Dade County Public Schools, our students and schools participated in the event to showcase their agricultural programs and products.

Among the wonderful district programs showcased this year were: William Turner Technical Senior High School, Felix Varela Senior High, J.C. Bermudez Senior High, Coconut Palm Middle, and J.F. Kennedy Middle School. Felix Varela High, William Turner Technical Arts High, J.C. Bermudez High, Coconut Palm Middle, and J.F.Kennedy Middle. All schools brought their related products and activities.

Since 2010, the Miami International Agriculture, Horse and Cattle Show has helped support educational programs and services in our community for children with autism, through their partnership with the South Florida Autism Charter School (SFACS). This partnership provides educational services to approximately 250 children with autism in Miami-Dade County.
