**SUBJECT: EXPULSION AND ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PROGRAM**

The Superintendent of Schools has recommended that these students be expelled from the regular and adult programs of Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) and assigned to an alternative school/program for the maximum time permitted by Florida State Statute, Section 1003.01.

Pursuant to School Board Policy 5610 – Suspension and Expulsion of Students, parents have been duly notified of the recommendation for expulsion and were given an opportunity for a conference with staff and were advised of the right to a hearing before an impartial hearing examiner.

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**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. expel the student specified in supplemental material SM-56 furnished under separate cover to School Board members, from the regular and adult programs of Miami-Dade County Public Schools and assigned to an alternative school/program for the maximum time permitted under law, which is the 2021-2022 school year, the 2022 summer session, and the 2022-2023 school year;
2. expel the student specified in supplemental material SM-59 furnished under separate cover to School Board members, from the regular and adult programs of Miami-Dade County Public Schools and assigned to an alternative school/program for the maximum time permitted under law, which is the 2021-2022 school year, the 2022 summer session, and the 2022-2023 school year;
3. expel the student specified in supplemental material SM-61 furnished under separate cover to School Board members, from the regular and adult programs of Miami-Dade County Public Schools and assigned to an alternative school/program for the maximum time permitted under law, which is the 2021-2022 school year, the 2022 summer session, and the 2022-2023 school year;
4. expel the student specified in supplemental material SM-73 furnished under separate cover to School Board members, from the regular and adult programs of Miami-Dade County Public Schools and assigned to an alternative school/program for the maximum time permitted under law, which is the 2021-2022 school year, the 2022 summer session, and the 2022-2023 school year; and
5. provide educational services in an alternative school/program during the term of the expulsion.

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
