**SUBJECT: REQUEST TO AMEND 2022 SCHOOL BOARD MEETING
 SCHEDULE**

At its Organization Meeting on November 16, 2021, the School Board established the schedule of School Board meetings for 2022, which included August 17, 2022, and November 23, 2022, as dates for regular School Board meetings. Subsequent to the approval of this schedule, on January 12, 2022, the School Board approved the 2022-2023 school calendars for elementary and secondary schools and adult/vocational education, which reflect a school start date of August 17, 2022. The school calendars approved in January 2022 also reflect three recess days for 10-month employees during the week of November 21, 2022, in observance of Thanksgiving.

In order to ensure that appropriate District-level support is available to schools on the first day students report for the 2022-2023 academic year, it is recommended that the August 17, 2022 School Board meeting be rescheduled to August 15, 2022. Further, recognizing the spirit with which the School Board approved the inclusion of three recess days immediately preceding Thanksgiving for 10-month employees in the 2022-2023 school calendar, it is also recommended that the November 23, 2022 School Board meeting be rescheduled to November 16, 2022, to better align with 12-month employee work schedules across the District.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

- 1) Reschedule the August 17, 2022 regular School Board meeting to August 15, 2022, at 11:00 a.m.; and
- 2) Reschedule the November 23, 2022 regular School Board meeting to November 16, 2022, at 11:00 a.m.
