SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ENDORSE THE 2022 INTERNATIONAL “WALK TO SCHOOL DAY”, AND IMPLEMENT THE “WALKSAFE” PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PROGRAM CURRICULUM DURING THE WEEK OF THE EVENT

International “Walk to School Day,” planned for October 12, 2022, is designed to promote awareness about pedestrian safety among students, parents, and schools. The program reinforces safe routes to schools and safe walking skills, as well as walking as exercise to combat childhood obesity. The program is environmentally friendly because it reduces pollution generated by school-related traffic and reinforces the importance of obeying school zone speed limits.

This safety awareness campaign is crucial in our communities, as concerning data provided by Nicklaus Children’s Hospital reveals that seven (7) children under the age of 15 were injured in traffic crashes in Miami-Dade County during 2021. Between January and July of 2022, Ryder Trauma Center of Jackson Memorial Hospital recorded that there were fourteen (14) injuries reported for children under the age of 15 related to traffic crashes.

In the 2021-2022 school year, 183 schools implemented the “WalkSafe” pedestrian safety program curriculum to coincide with the “Walk to School Day” event. The Office of Physical Education and Health Literacy will continue to spearhead its implementation at all District elementary schools. “WalkSafe” was created by the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine to reduce pediatric pedestrian injuries and fatalities. Both programs are operated at no cost to the District.
