On June 23, 2021, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida approved the *Infinite Possibilities*, Miami-Dade County Public School's 2021-2026 Strategic Plan grounded in a theory of action tied to our mission to provide relevant learning experiences that foster life-long curiosity and enable all students to achieve their full academic, personal, and civic potential. This five-year blueprint is structured around five pillars, with a series of 16 identified Priorities and a total of 56 Objectives.

Pursuant to School Board Policy 0173, *District Strategic Plan*, annually, the School Board must be provided an update on the status and progress toward achievement of the Objectives and Priorities delineated in *Infinite Possibilities*, the District's 2021-2026 Strategic Plan. Through policy and practice, monitoring progress is essential to success. As such, the District has undergone a coordinated effort to examine the year one outcomes coupled with evaluation of the impact of unanticipated and evolving changes and challenges in the educational landscape to: (1) assess progress towards achievement of our goals, and (2) recommend appropriate adjustments, for the School Board's consideration.

Phase I of this Report is based on the data available as of September 30, 2022. District Staff is in the process of finalizing the Annual Report which will include the year one outcomes, summary of status, and recommendations for adjustments. Phase I of the Annual Report is incorporated by reference and will be submitted to the School Board prior to the Board Meeting of October 19, 2022, for review and approval and copies will be filed with the Office of the Board Recording Secretary and the Citizen Information Center.

Should the School Board approve Phase I of the Report, including the recommended adjustments and/or proffer additional adjustments through this process, the final results will be incorporated into the official Annual Report and transmitted to the School Board, displayed on the District's Website and copies will be filed with the Citizen Information Center. Phase II of this Report will address goals that are pending data. The Phase II goals and outcomes will be submitted as a separate Board item for consideration and approval once data becomes available. It is anticipated that all pending goals will be transmitted to the School Board no later than January 31, 2023.

**RECOMMENDED:**       That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve Phase I of the 2022 Annual Report of the Miami-Dade County Public Schools' 2021-2026 Strategic Plan, *Infinite Possibilities*, based on data available as of September 30, 2022.
