SUBJECT: AWARD TO MAGNUM CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, LLC D/B/A MCM. THE NEW CLASSROOM ADDITION PROJECT AT ALONZO AND TRACY MOURNING SENIOR HIGH BISCAYNE BAY; PROJECT NUMBER 02092300

Background:

On July 5, 2022, a solicitation was published to competitively bid (Hard Bid) the new classroom addition project at Alonzo and Tracy Mourning Senior High Biscayne Bay. Bids have been received and this item provides a recommendation for award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Eight (8) pre-qualified contractors attended the mandatory pre-bid conference conducted on July 19, 2022. Five (5) sealed bids were received, and these were opened on August 11, 2022, at the School Board Administration Building Auditorium. District staff from the Office of School Facilities, staff from the Office of Economic Opportunity and the Project Architect witnessed the bid opening.

After analysis of the bid tabulation (see Attachment A), it was determined that Magnum Construction Management, LLC d/b/a MCM (MCM) was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, with a Base Bid price of \$12,046,000.00. No alternates are being taken; however, the award amount is being reduced by \$240,920.00 as a result of sales tax savings generated by the District's Direct Materials Procurement Program. Consequently, district staff and the project architect, Gurri Matute, P.A. recommend awarding the project to MCM in the amount of \$11,805,080.00.

The contract provides for compliance with Small Business Enterprise, Micro Business Enterprise and Minority/Women Business Enterprise utilization goals. The Office of Economic Opportunity staff reviewed the SBE, MBE and M/WBE certification status of all subcontractors and verified the existence of a Letter of Intent for each, outlining roles and responsibilities.

Small/ Micro Business Utilization:

A mandatory S/MBE participation goal of 8.08% for Construction was established for this project (as determined by the M-DCPS Goal Setting Committee). Identified below are the S/MBE firms that MCM will use on the project.

Minority/Women Business Enterprise Utilization:

A mandatory M/WBE participation goal 16.92%; encompassing Non-Minority Women, African American, Native American and Asian American-owned firms; was established for this project (as determined by the M-DCPS Goal Setting Committee). Per the Disparity Study and Policy 6320.02.

Identified below are the S/MBE and M/WBE firms that MCM will use on the project. Additional S/MBE and/or M/WBE subcontractors may be included in the project as the contractor finalizes awarding of all the subcontracts.

The Office of Economic Opportunity shall monitor the above-stated goals for compliance.

MCM is required to report monthly on SBE/MBE and M/WBE Utilization to OEO. All compliance reporting shall be submitted through the M-DCPS Online Diversity Compliance System.

Description and Scope

Alonzo and Tracy Mourning Senior High Biscayne Bay is located at 2601 N.E. 151 Street, North Miami, Florida 33160. The site is bordered on the north by the North District Wastewater Treatment Plant, on the east by Oleta River State Park, on the west by FIU Stadium Drive and on the south by N.E. 151 Street. The existing school was built in 2008 and is currently comprised of one (1) permanent building, situated on an approximately 5-acre parcel of land. The facility has 1,521 student stations which will increase to 1,971 student stations upon completion of this project.

Project Scope:

The-scope of work for this project includes the construction of a new, 3-story classroom addition, approximately 23,387 square feet with 450 new student stations:

- ❖ Sixteen (16) Classrooms and One (1) Collaboration Room
- ❖ Shelter/basketball courts
- ❖ Bleachers
- ❖ Two Staff Offices
- ❖ Elevator
- ❖ Four Group Restroom
- ❖ Two Staff Restroom
- ❖ Scoreboard and related site adaptation
- ❖ New covered walkway to connect the new building to the existing facility
- ❖ Restoration of landscape area and perimeter conditions
- ❖ Demolition of existing hardcourts and basketball standards
- ❖ New Mechanical and Electrical rooms
- ❖ Fire Alarm
- ❖ Intrusion Alarm and Security Camera systems
- ❖ PA and Clock
